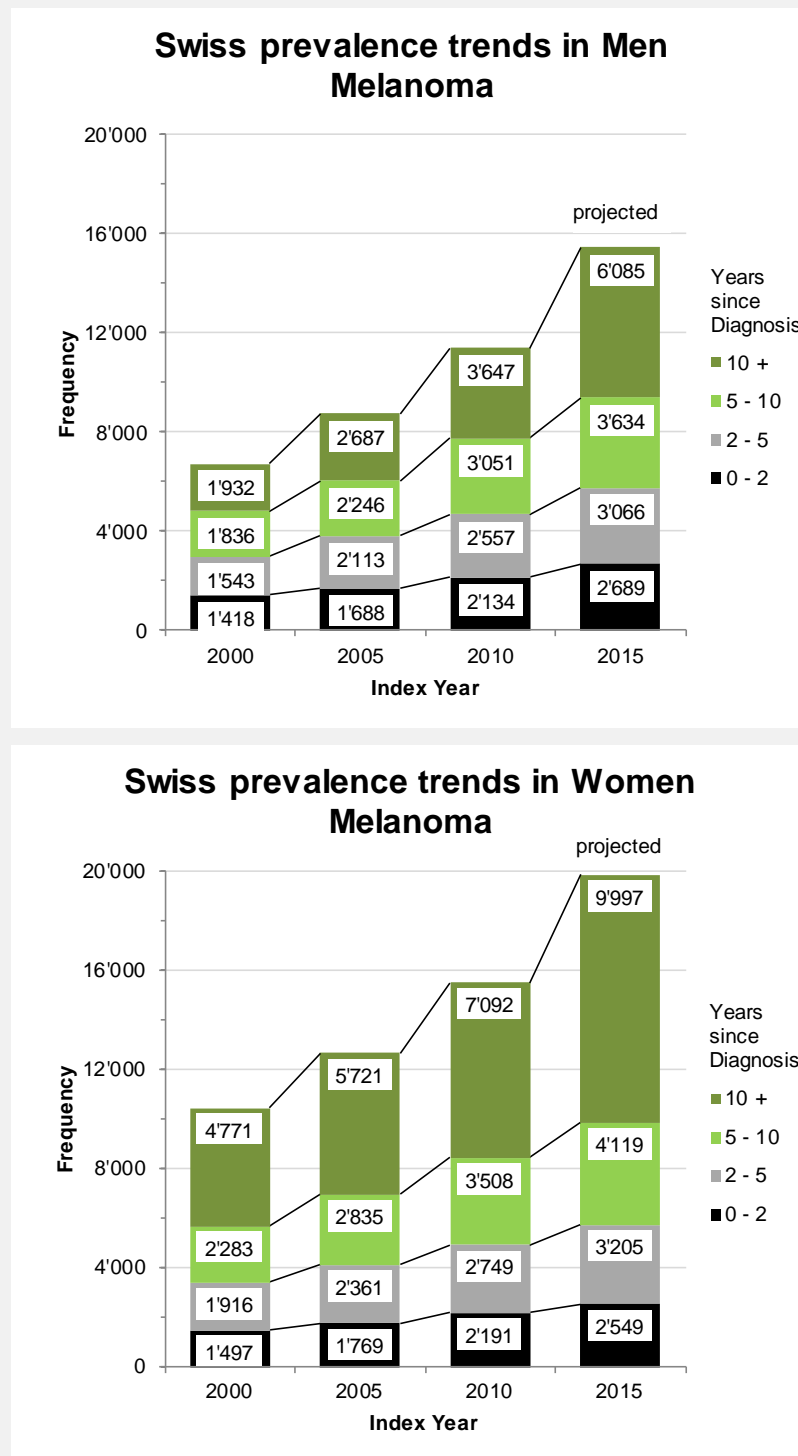


# PREVALENCE of **MELANOMA of the skin** in SWITZERLAND
